

How to Find a Shipper to Get Donated Goods to Haiti

Contact your local Red Cross, United Way or Salvation Army and ask them if they ship donated goods to Haiti. If they do ask them if they will partner with you on your donation drive and ensure your goods will get to Haiti. Tell them you are only collecting orthopaedic devices (used or new crutches, canes, walkers, wheelchairs, leg and knee braces) or medical supplies. If you accept anything else you most likely will **NOT** find anyone willing to ship the goods you collect so you will have wasted time and effort. For example do NOT accept clothing.

If they can't help you ask them if they can refer you to someone else who might be able to help you. You can also try **charitynavigator.org** to find a relief shipper, large local churches that may be working with relief organizations in Haiti, major hospitals (who may be sending teams of doctors to Haiti).

If you are unable to find anyone and you have a large shipment such as a container of medical supplies or new crutches for example, contact us. Our partner relief forwarder will make arrangements to pick up the goods.

If you are unable to find anyone locally find some way (rent a truck for example) to get your donated goods here to Florida, but it will be at your expense. Raise cash donations to do this. Contact us first to confirm your delivery before making these arrangements.
